

FINGER SOFT DOUGH

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Suitable for use by children age 3+.

Always protect work surfaces, furnishings and clothes while using Finger Soft Dough as it may stain. Stains on clothes can sometimes be removed by soaking overnight before washing.

To remove Finger Soft Dough from carpets and fabrics, do not use hot water or cleaning solutions. For best results, remove the excess dough before letting it dry. For carpets, use a stiff brush to break up the hardened dough and vacuum clean. For fabrics, scrape away the dried dough and vacuum clean if possible, then wash with mild soap and cold water.

To keep Finger Soft Dough pliable and soft always return the dough to its original container, with the lid firmly closed, when not in use and store in a cool place. If necessary, add one drop of water or wrap the Finger Soft Dough in a wet towel to restore its softness. Use only an old and unimportant towel as it may stain.

Finger Soft Dough is a high quality, versatile and easy to use modelling dough. It is designed to be a fun way of encouraging creativity in children. Kneading, twisting, rolling and squeezing the dough allows children to make an endless range of shapes and configurations. Colours can be mixed to produce new colours, swirls or patterns.

Moulds and pastry cutters can be used to make shapes of animals, vehicles, geometric shapes, etc. Modelling tools can be used to create fine detail and add texture to creations. Finger Soft Dough is suitable for extrusion with most of the available dough extruders.

Models can be made permanent by allowing Finger Soft Dough to air dry. However, finished pieces may be brittle, particularly if they are delicate with fine detail. Newclay and Air Dough are more suitable modelling materials for making permanent models.
